After a brief introduction about the guest lecture, our principal briefed about the communication skills, she signified the prominence of the English language and communication skills.

Smt. Roopa G.S the resource person delivered an eloquent, impeccable speech on the 21st century soft skills, her depth of knowledge was so vast, she encouraged the students to cultivate the habit of reading in library, by going through different varieties of books available in library. She said reading plays a major role in improving communication skills that is listening, speaking, reading and writing skills which are given more significance.

Communication, at its simplest, is the act of transferring information. The ability to communicate information accurately, clearly and as intended, is a vital life skill and something that should not be overlooked. Communication today is very important both in business world as well as in private life.

Listening and reading are the decoding aspect of speaking and writing. Speaking and writing are the encoding means to the problem solving agents. Communicative skills are very important and necessary tools to interact with students and to import the knowledge.

Further she enlightened about Time management, innovative learning, digital learning and creative life style which are also the parts of soft skills. Through learning and innovation, students will be productive employers of the institution. It improves life skills and upgrades students' digital learning and social skills. They should learn how to treat people with respect and affection, they should also learn to smile with others. Smiling is a very important aspect of solving many problems in our daily routine.

She also spoke about Sympathy and empathy these are the words which deals with the relationship a person has to the feelings and experiences of another person: sympathy is nothing but sharing the feelings of another; empathy is understanding the feelings of another

The resource person outlined the Soft skills as, the character traits and interpersonal skills that characterize a person's relationships with other people. In the workplace, soft skills are considered to be a complement to hard skills, which refer to T person's knowledge and occupational skills.

- Through soft skills one can learn to be sympathetic with those who are in need.

- Helps to be a good public speaker.
- Helps to be a good listener.
